Onondaga Earth Corps (OEC) is almost 20!

Inclusive of this year's youth and young adult cohort, over 400 youth will have served 115,000+ hours towards personal growth, community engagement, neighborhood beautification and environmental improvements in the City of Syracuse and Central New York. Today, the Eli MacDonald Green Team our six-week pilot project which started in 2003, is in the final stages of receiving accreditation from The Corps Network (TCN) – the national association of conservation corps.


Accreditation from TCN affirms that OEC is following the best practices for conservation corps developed by programs dating back to the Civilian Conservation Corps of the 1930s and sets a framework to sustain a high quality program for years to come. It opens the door to funding opportunities in partnership with The Corps Network and other national agencies that would be otherwise unreachable. OEC has put great effort into updating and refining our policies, procedures and practices as a program and organization in pursuit of reaching this long term goal.

Accreditation is awesome and yet there's more to reaching new heights in 2022! This spring OEC reached another important milestone in promoting some of our program graduates to key staff positions. Crews are out taking care of a portion of the 10,000+ trees planted in recent years as part of Onondaga County's Save the Rain Program. We have started planting trees in support of the City reaching its goal of increasing canopy by 7% over the next 20 years. And, we are piloting a year round youth program in collaboration with CNY Works! With the support of our dedicated staff, youth in our program have a platform to find their voice, learn new skills, engage with the community and be gainfully employed.

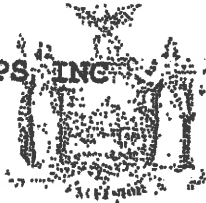

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Throughout the pandemic, and as society moves towards some sense of normalcy, the world and our communities have faced unprecedented uncertainties. To weather the storm has required resiliency, community, and commitment. This year, OEC has continued to work on enhancements to the new portion of the Onondaga Creekwalk that passes through the heart of Syracuse, where OEC has its roots. In partnership with CNY Works, NYS Senator Pamela Hunter's office and our project partners at the City of Syracuse, we are implementing the largest after school youth program we have ever run and will have resources to keep some youth crew members over the winter to help staff plan projects with partners for 2022!

On behalf of the Board of Directors and the staff and crew at OEC, we thank you for your enduring support in 2021 and look forward to staying connected with you in 2022.

The Mission of the OEC is to empower youth to be active participants in creating positive change for themselves, their communities and the environment.

OEC- PAST AND PRESENT

The OEC began as the Eli MacDonald Green Team in 2004. The initiative was created by MacDonald, a veteran and activist, when he identified the need for young people to be active in beautifying their neighborhoods and landscaping properties for elderly and disabled residents. In 2005, the program adopted the youth conservation corps model and changed its name to Onondaga Earth Corps.

The OEC models itself on the highly successful and effective Youth Conservation Corps model that has been in operation throughout the United States since the 1930's to address critical environmental and human service needs. Corps programs lead to positive impacts on participants' employment and earnings, teach them valuable job readiness and technical skills for the future, and provide needed services.

OEC crew members participate in urban forestry projects, stormwater management projects, private property management and community environmental education and outreach.

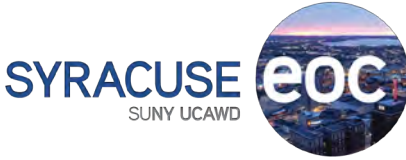

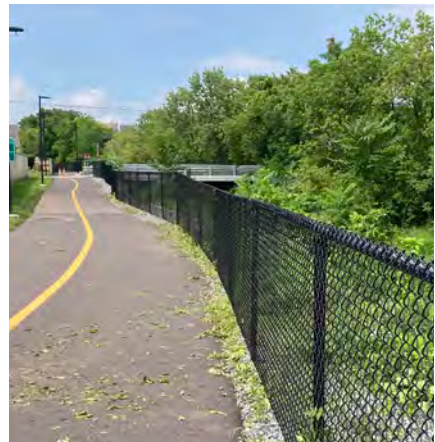

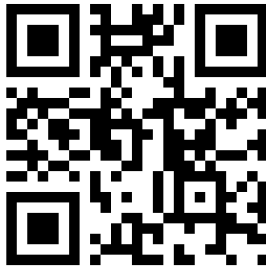
